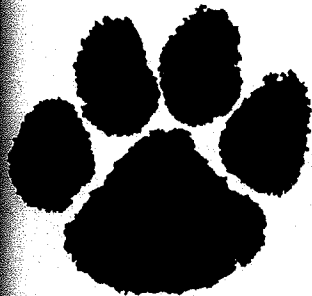

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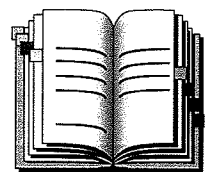
FROM THE DESK OF MR. HAYES

No Child Left Behind News...

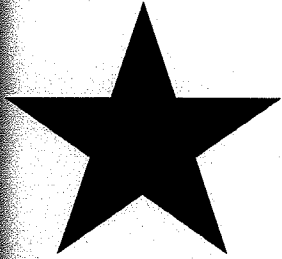

We are proud to present our January "Star" Students. These students were careful with their work, attended school and are good role models. Congratulations January "Star" Students.

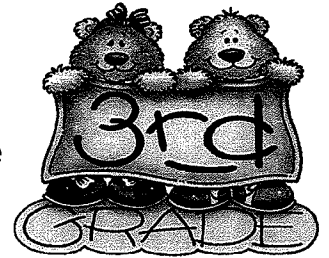
